S.R.O. No./2019. - In exercise of the powers conferred by section 565 read with 407 of the Kerala Municipality Act, 1994 (20 of 1994), the Government of Kerala hereby make the following rules further to amend the Kerala Municipality Building (Regularisation of



Unauthorised Construction) Rules, 2018, issued under G.O.(P)No.11/2018/LSGD. dated 15th February, 2018 and published as S.R.O. No.95/2018 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No.407 dated 20th February, 2018, namely:-

RULES

- 1. *Short title and commencement*.—(1) These rules may be called the Kerala Municipality Building (Regularisation of Unauthorised Construction) Amendment Rules, 2019.
 - (2) They shall be deemed to have come in to force on the 20th day of February, 2018.
- 2. Amendment of the rules.-In the Kerala Municipality Building (Regularisation of Unauthorised Construction) Rules, 2018, in rule 3, in sub-rule (1), for the words "four hundred and five", the words "five hundred and eighty eight" shall be substituted.

Explanatory Note

(This does not form part of the notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

As per sub-rule (1) of rule 3 of the Kerala Municipality Building (Regularisation of Unauthorised Construction) Rules, 2018 issued under G.O.(P)No.11/2018/LSGD. dated 15th February, 2018 and published as S.R.O. No.95/2018 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No.407 dated 20th February, 2018, the time-limit for filing the application for regularisation of unauthorised construction had been ninety days. As per G.O.(P)No.47/2018/LSGD. dated 20th June, 2018 and published as S.R.O. No.422/2018 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No.1661 dated 22nd June, 2018, the said time-limit had been extended to two hundred and seventy days. As per G.O.(P)No.89/2018/LSGD. dated 30th November, 2018 and published as S.R.O. No.867/2018 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No.3056 dated 4th December, 2018, the said

time-limit had been further extended to four hundred and five days. The said time-limit expired on 31st March, 2019. The Government have, therefore, decided to extend the said time-limit up to 30th September, 2019 so as to provide an opportunity to those who could not file application in time.

The notification is intended to achieve the above object.
